STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS: Store in a cool, dry place.

530 000 i.u. Dihydrostreptomycin sulphate

WARNINGS

- ALLOW 7 DAYS BETWEEN LAST APPLICATION AND SLAUGHTER FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION.
- MILK FROM TREATED COWS, INCLUDING UNTREATED QUARTERS, MUST NOT BE USED FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION OR INDUSTRIAL PURPOSES OR BE MIXED WITH NORMAL MILK WHILE VISIBLY COLOURED BLUE/GREEN AND FOR 24 HOURS THEREAFTER.
- Keep out of reach of children, uninformed persons and animals.
- Although this remedy has been extensively tested under a large variety of conditions, failure thereof may ensue as a result of a wide range of reasons. If this is suspected, seek veterinary advice and notify the registration holder.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: USE ONLY AS DIRECTED

Treat the common forms of mastitis as follows:

- Disinfect teat thoroughly, milk out and again disinfect.
- Remove cap. Insert nozzle into teat canal and squeeze out entire contents of the syringe.
- Gently massage to distribute contents to all sections of the quarter.
- Administer the contents of 1 syringe per affected quarter after milking.
- During the period of treatment the udder must be milked out every 12 hours as usual.
- After the third milking subsequent to the initiation of treatment, a second syringe of Dispolac RX4B must be administered to the affected quarter following the method described above.

Important

Rapid release of the antibiotic means that milk quickly returns to normal and is suitable for human consumption and industrial manufacture 24 hours after blue/green discolouration has disappeared from the milk.
